Sons of Jubal is a community wide Christian stage band, in the Southern Bay Area of California, primarily playing big band arrangements of old hymns and contemporary praise music. The name comes from Genesis 4:21 which tells us that Jubal is the father of all musicians. In scripture to be a "son" implies that you have the right to inherit from the father. For example, in Romans 8, the Bible describes a Christian as "the firstborn among many brothers" indicating an even greater share of the inheritance.

Since its inception in June of 2000, Sons of Jubal has performed at a variety of venues. Our goal, in addition to providing entertainment, is to create opportunities for telling people about the Good News of Jesus by giving concerts throughout the community.

## What We Believe

That the Bible is God's inspired Word and is the divine authority by which Christians are called to live. We believe that both the Old and New Testaments are verbally inspired by God and error-free in the original text.

That man, because of his personal sin, needs to be made whole and restored to fellowship with God through Jesus Christ. We believe that all who receive by faith the Lord Jesus Christ are born of the Holy Spirit, and thereby become children of God, a relationship in which they are eternally secure.
